In addition to these two exciting experiences, you will also enjoy views of the Falls from above at various points like, Prospect Point, Terrapin Point and many more all while your guide provides you with an ongoing quick-witted commentary of the rich history... and mystery of the Niagara Region. Learn about how a club fostered jazz, the growth of music and unity during a time when segregation prevailed. After your uplifting experience in the world of music at the Colored Musicians Club, head over to one of the great restaurants serving some of the best soul food this side of the Mississippi. After lunch, your spiritual journey will take you up to Niagara Falls to see and learn about its relationship to the slave trade. You will see where Harriet Tubman herself crossed into Canada after her escape. Finish the day staring up at the Mighty Niagara Falls as the Maid of the Mist boat cruise takes you into the belly of the Horseshoe Falls. Feel what it would have been like to try and cross the great Niagara River.

Learn of the rise and fall of the industrialist, Martin and how he died penniless along with the near demise of Graycliff.

These gardens surround you with natural beauty and award-winning botanical collections.
